- You will then need to check the email and/or text box next to Announcement Posted.

Book Bee

It is time to start forming our Book Bee academic competition teams! Each grade level team (3, 4, 5, 6, and a combined Jr. High team) works together to read and know 12 books (just 6 books for our 3rd graders this year) among up to 12 team members. The book list is available here and is on myHTPS Parent Pages, too.

On the day of the competition, the team sits together to answer three questions about each book per round. Teams in the top half after Round 1 advance to Round 2. After Round 2, the top three teams receive awards. There is no audience for the competition, as students are there to compete with all schools present and compete at the same time in a school's gym. Guests can join them for awards.

Teams usually meet after school from 3 - 4 pm every other week in February, March, and weekly in April for practices. The practice day of the week is chosen by the coach and team. The competition is just one Saturday in mid to late April and usually lasts around two hours for each grade. Book Bee includes minimal commitment compared to other activities.

To sign your child up for this competition, <u>complete the online form</u> by January 22.

We need at least one coach per grade level to be able to have a team - and coaching is quite simple, as students read the book and write practice questions while reading to use during practices.

Tennis sign-ups

Holy Trinity will compete in the Spring Catholic/Independent School Tennis League with matches held at Louisville Indoor Racquet Club (8609 Westport Road).

WHO CAN PLAY? - Any 3rd through 8th grader. While all levels of playing abilities are welcome to play, players must have a rating of 1.5 to compete. Players must be able to serve and keep score for matches. All players need to register through Game Day.

Please sign up as soon as possible. We need to provide the league leadership our roster by Monday January 22nd.

MATCH SCHEDULE - Matches will be played on the following Saturday afternoons (1pm-7pm): 2/24, 3/2, 3/9, 3/16, 3/23 and 4/13 followed by Tournament play on Sunday 4/21. The matches last one hour at LIRC culminating in the league tournament. We will play 8 courts each week consisting of singles and double matches. All players will need to have a rating (1.5 - 4.0). This rating helps the coaches coordinate the matches based on player abilities so everyone is playing an opponent at their level.

PRACTICES - Date and time will be communicated once we know the size of the team.

RATINGS VERIFICATION - Ratings verifications will take place in mid-January with a make-up rating session (final date TBD) and a \$5 cash fee per player for the make-up rating session.

REGISTRATION FEES - The registration fee is \$115 and includes match court time and match play, team t-shirt and rating clinic, and practices (tennis pros and court rental fees).
