Probationary Status Agreement

Determining whether a student is a candidate for Holy Trinity Clifton School is a very important and thorough process. It is imperative for all parties to be certain that the student is a proper candidate and the school has the necessary resources to meet the student needs. Measures taken to determine this (but not limited to) include: A complete full educational/psychological assessment (or similar), review of previous school report cards and informal assessments, review of standardized tests or progress reports, an informational phone-call to the current school, a tour/interview with parent/guardian, assessments conducted at HTCS, and a shadow day for the student (contingent upon age).

All newly enrolled students are accepted on a **probationary status**. Administration and teachers will be in close communication with parent/guardian in the event that a student's enrollment at Holy Trinity Clifton School is in question. Reasons that this may occur include: the child's academic needs no longer warrant remedial resources, behavior concerns, lack of positive collaborative support between school and parent/guardian, etc.

I understand that my student is enrolled on a probationary status. I also understand that my application fee will not be refunded and any tuition will be refunded on a pro-rated basis.
